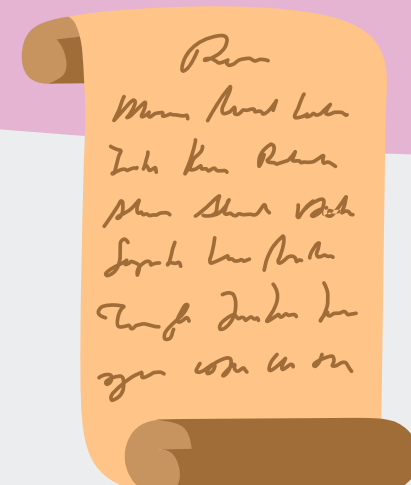

- 3) Listening to a talk is one way of learning. What do you think about doing projects as another way of learning?



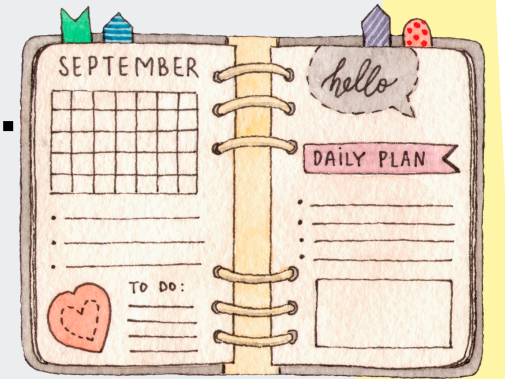

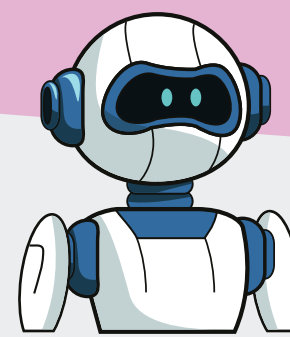


Day 2: Timetable
